youth mentoring program offered to the children of Blair County between the ages of 6 and 17 years who primarily reside in single-parent or assigned to guardian families, have an incarcerated parent, or have a family history of substance abuse or domestic violence. Youth are provided with the opportunity to enhance their confidence and competence and to become a caring individual by providing them with a screened and trained high school student, college student or adult mentor with whom they can do a variety of activities. Through the end of December 2015, there were 33 school site matches in Blair County - Bellwood-Antis Middle School, 14 matches; Penn-Lincoln Elementary, 16 matches; North Juniata, 3 matches. All matches were progressing well as documented through interviews with Match Support Specialists and through utilization of the evaluation tool, Youth Outcome Survey. Additional surveys will be completed at the end of the school year.
